### Schweizer 300CBi



The 300CBi helicopter offers all the handling characteristics required for understanding the basics of helicopter aerodynamics during the initial stages of training. The high skid platform and instrumentation give it a big helicopter feel, making it perfect for transitioning to bigger aircraft. This helicopter is the ideal machine on which aspiring helicopter pilots gain the required skills necessary to pursue a commercial helicopter career.

### Robinson R44 Raven II



The R44 Raven II is a four-seat light helicopter produced by Robinson Helicopter Company. It is a single-engine helicopter with a semi-rigid two-bladed main rotor, a two-bladed tail rotor and features hydraulically assisted flight controls. It is one of the most widely used light helicopters in general aviation throughout Australia. Consequently it is highly likely that a newly qualified helicopter pilot would get their first job flying this machine.



## Entry Requirements

- Hold a CASA medical certificate
- Operational restrictions on the Schweizer 300CBi require students to weigh less than 105 kg and to be in good physical health. The Robinson R44 weight limit is 130 kg, if your weight is more than 105 kg the entire course needs to be done on the R44.
- Successfully pass FTA's selection program, consisting of:
  - Aptitude assessment and interview
  - Core skills test (if applicable)
  - Application for recognised prior learning
  - Computer-based aviation theory assessment program.
