- Evidence of previous flying experience (if applicable), e.g. logbook copies, flight crew licences and ground theory credits.
- Copy of senior school certificate or Certificate IV or higher qualification.

Duration: Allow 4 hours

Selection day

Non-FTA students - Cost \$488

One hour flight check in a DA40 aircraft, demonstrating knowledge and skill in aircraft control, procedures and flight management to CPL standard.

- Interview with senior manager.

FTA students. Students are assessed through performance in previous training.

- Candidates without a Year 12 or Certificate IV or higher qualification will complete the Core Skills Profile for Adults assessments in numeracy and reading. An exit level of 3 is required in both tests to be eligible for VET Student Loans.

How to prepare for selection

Complete the provided electronic aviation theory course as thoroughly as possible in preparation for a theory assessment on selection day.

Prepare for the interview by reading the sections in FTA's Student Handbook* on what to expect from training and the obligations regarding VET Student Loans.

Selection Day

1. Aviation theory assessment. FTA will provide candidates with a directed self-paced course of abbreviated aviation theory two weeks before selection day. Selection will start with an assessment of the candidate's aviation knowledge based on the course material. Candidates who pass the theory assessment will progress to the next stage of selection.

2. Aptitude Test - Cost \$200

Candidates will complete a two-hour computer-based aviation aptitude test, which determines aviation specific psychometric competencies, e.g. information processing, complex coordination and spatial ability.

3. Interview. After the aptitude test the candidates will get an opportunity to discuss their training goals and test results with a senior manager.

4. Academic eligibility. Candidates without a Year 12 or Certificate IV or higher qualification will complete the Core Skills Profile for Adults assessments in numeracy and reading. An exit level of 3 is required in both tests to be eligible for VET Student Loans.

How to prepare for the course

Candidates should revise Year 10 Maths and Year 11 Physics before course commencement. FTA will make compulsory pre-course study material available to students four weeks before the start date. The study material includes further assessments in aviation theory. Students who fail to complete the study material may not be considered ready for training and may be moved to a later course.
